Delhi, The political capital of India, Delhi, makes up one of the cornerstones of the golden triangle in the country's north. The India Gate, Red Fort, Jam Masjid, Chandni Chowk, Kutub Minar, Jantar-Mantar, Laxmi Narayan Temple, Akshardham Temple, Bahai Temple and many more are worth seeing in Delhi. The city is the perfect mix of the old and the new. From the colonial pillars of Connaught Place to the lanes of Chandni Chowk and the malls of South Extension, you will find discover a whole range of experiences here. Delhi is also a paradise for shopping, eating and sight-seeing.

Agra is a medieval city on the banks of Yamuna River was founded by Sultan Sikandar Lodi in 1565. It achieved fame as the capital of the Mughal emperors from 1526 to 1658 and remains a major tourist destination because of its many splendid Mughal-era buildings, most notably the Taj Mahal, Agra Fort and Fatehpur Sikri, all three of which are UNESCO World Heritage Sites.

At Ranthambore National Park, the tiger rules the jungle. This nearly 400 sq. Km wide stretch of land in Rajasthan is where these majestic animals reside, roaming amidst verdant greenery along with other animals and birds. Unfortunately, due to its dwindling population, spotting a tiger is a matter of luck, but it is still one of the few places on earth where you can witness tigers in their natural habitat. A jeep safari at the park is not just an exciting adventure but is a chance to explore nature in its truest form. It makes people realize the importance of conserving endangered species, to balance the ecosystem of the earth. The National Park is also home to numerous historic structures, including the magnificent Ranthambore Fort, several temples, mosques, lakes and hunting pavilions. The villages in and around the park give you a glimpse inside the simple life led by the local people of Ranthambore. Walk around the villages, and you will be mesmerized by the vibrant culture of Rajasthan, where you will realize that the state does live up to the hype.

Jaipur, the picturesque capital of Rajasthan also known as the Pink city was founded in 1727 by Maharaja Sawai Jai Sing II. It was first planned city in India, beautifully laid out gardens and parks, attractive monuments and marvelous heritage hotels, which were once the residence of Maharajas, are worthy of admiration. Visit to Amber fort, City Palace, Jantar-Mantar, Hawa Mahal, the ambling camels and cheerful people in multi-hued costumes will make your trip to the pink city a memorable one.
