#### **Day 5** On to Bucharest & City tour (Romania)

Started in 1984 (and still unfinished), the 330,000-sq-metre building has more than 3000 rooms.

Later visit Bran Castle also known the world as "Dracula Castle ",is the only castle in all of Transylvania that actually fits Bram Stoker's description of Dracula's Castle,. Stoker's character, Count Dracula, first appeared in the novel "Dracula", published in England in 1897, by the Irish writer Bram Stoker.
